

Statement from the South African Petroleum Industry Association

Update on the supply of petroleum products in Gauteng

22 December 2011 – SAPIA, the South African Petroleum Industry Association confirms that the petroleum industry is experiencing fuel supply constraints in some areas of Gauteng.

“The supply situation is being closely monitored by the Logistics Planning Team, which consists of members of the petroleum industry, the Department of Energy and Transnet,” said Avhaphani Tshifularo, the executive director of the South African Petroleum Industry Association.

Some service stations may face sporadic shortages of one or more grades of fuel as oil companies try to reduce the delivery back-log.

“Everything possible is being done to improve the situation and we will continue to keep the public updated.”
